### **BYLAW C-1133**

## A Bylaw to Close Government Road Allowance

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Council of the City of Grande Prairie, in the Province of Alberta, has given notice in the manner and form prescribed by Section 22 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, RSA 2000, of its intention to pass a bylaw for the purpose of closing road described as:

"Meridian 6 Range 5 Township 71

All that portion of the Statutory Government Road Allowance

Adjacent to the NW 18-71-5-6

Lying North East of the production northwesterly across the said Road Allowance of the North East limit of Railway Plan 1712 RS and South West of the curvilinear production across said Road Allowance of the South West limit of Road Plan 1850 RS."

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

**WHEREAS** the said Council held a Public Meeting on September 20, 2004, at which any person who claimed his property would be affected prejudicially by the said road closure was given an opportunity to be heard by City Council.

# NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDE PRAIRIE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
