BYLAW C-1259

**A Bylaw to Authorize the City of Grande Prairie,
in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of
Designating a Parcel of Land as Municipal Reserve**

WHEREAS the Section 665, Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c. M-26, as amended, authorizes Council, by bylaw, to designate a parcel of land as Municipal Reserve.

AND WHEREAS Council desires to designate a parcel of land as Municipal Reserve.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDE PRAIRIE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the parcel of land legally described as:

PLAN 022-2748

BLOCK 11

LOT 72

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

Area: 0.814 hectares (2.01 acres) more or less

be designated as Municipal Reserve subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulation.

2. This bylaw shall take effect on the date it is passed.

READ a second time this 11th day of July, 2011.

READ a third time and finally passed this 11th day of July, 2011.
