BY-LAW C-898

**A By-law of the City of Grande Prairie to
Provide Penalties for Infractions of By-law**

WHEREAS it is provided in and by the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 1980 and amendments thereto that the Council may enact a general penalty by-law, and

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of Grande Prairie deems it necessary to enact a general penalty by-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDE PRAIRIE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Any person found guilty of the contravention of any by-law of the City of Grande Prairie for which no other penalty is provided shall upon summary conviction pay a fine not exceeding Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) and costs for every offence, and in default of payment, judgement.
2. Where a conviction is for non-payment of a license fee or voluntary penalty payable to the City of Grande Prairie under by-law, the Provincial Judge or Justice of the Peace may adjudge payment thereof in addition to the penalty.
3. By-law C-761 is hereby repealed.
4. This By-law shall come into effect on the date of final reading thereof.
