The United Way Emergency Fund was accessed 87 times in 2012, totaling in over 300 individuals and children served.

The reasons for accessing the fund

Rent assistance was accessed **44** times
Utilities assistance was accessed **22** times
Other (food, transportation, prescriptions, back to work) was accessed **21** times

Cool Aid Society After School Program – an average of 980 youth (ages 6-17) that visit the centre monthly.

Low Income Recreation Access (LIRA) – **517** Adults, Children and Seniors received a **\$100.00** credit to put towards any City of Grande Prairie recreation program or facility in 2012.

Seniors Property Tax Rebate – 447 seniors received a \$100.00 rebate in 2012.

AISH Transit Pass – an average of 172 free passes for individuals on AISH supports are administered monthly.

Coats for Kids

2011 – **3897** coats, pants, mitts and toques were administered to local adults and children.

2012 – approximately 4000 coats, pants, mitts and toques were administered to local adults and children.








