

**CITY OF GRANDE PRAIRIE**

**BYLAW 1454**

**A Bylaw to designate the Grande Prairie Courthouse (1957)  
as a Municipal Historic Resource**

**WHEREAS** the Historical Resources Act, RSA 2000, Chapter H-9, as amended (the “Act”), permits Council to designate any Historic Resource within the City of Grande Prairie, whose preservation Council considers to be in the public interest due to their heritage value, together with any land on which it is located as a Municipal Historic Resource;

**AND WHEREAS** the Owner(s) of the Grande Prairie Courthouse have been given sixty (60) days written notice of the intention to pass this Bylaw in accordance with the Act.

**NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDE PRAIRIE, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Grande Prairie Courthouse (1957) located on land legally describes as:  
“Plan 1246CL, Block 2, Lot A, excepting thereout all mines and minerals.”

**BUILDINGS AND LANDS DESIGNATED AS A MUNICIPAL HISTORIC RESOURCE**

2. The lands shall not be destroyed, disturbed, altered, restored, removed, or repaired other than with the written approval of Council or a person appointed by Council.
3. The City Manager is hereby appointed to administer the implementation of any matters arising from this Bylaw.
4. This Bylaw shall take effect on the date it is passed.

**READ** a first time this 12 day of December, 2022.

**READ** a second time this 12 day of December, 2022.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 12 day of December, 2022.
