

STATUS UPDATE



Council's 2022–2025 Strategic Plan outlines projects and initiatives that align with four strategic pillars consisting of Quality of Life, Innovative Efficiencies & Economic Readiness, Inclusive Caring Community, and Engaging Relationships. Many successes have occurred to-date, including the completion of the following projects and initiatives:





ROAD STRUCTURE REVIEW

- A comprehensive technical review of the City's road structure was completed in 2023.
- This project reviewed the pavement performance of various roadways throughout in the City including local, collector, and arterial roadways.
- The City will be implementing various recommendations to improve the lifespan and durability of our roadways.
- Roadways paved in the City can incorporate up to 30% recycled asphalt material, reducing the cost and environmental impact.
- Arterial roadways in the City consist of nearly ¾ of a meter of gravel and asphalt.

SPORT TOURISM FUNCTION: BUSINESS CASE

- Municipal investment in sport tourism has proven to have significant direct and indirect economic and social impacts on communities while fostering youth sport development.
- An updated Grande Prairie Sports Tourism Strategy is required to provide relevant strategic direction to the future development of sport tourism initiatives.
- An updated Sport Tourism Strategy will guide how the City will grow the sport tourism industry as a significant economic, social, and cultural driver for the community.
- Council has directed the pursuit of several major sporting events, which has led to the successful bidding on the 2024 Alberta Winter Games, 2024 National Aboriginal Hockey Championships, the 2025 Special Olympics Alberta Summer Games and 2026 Wrestling National Championships.

Additional projects and initiatives completed include Land Inventory Gap Analysis, Cyber Security Strategy, Bike Park Construction at Crystal Lake, Transit Redesign, Public Security Unit Proposal, Current State of Policing Assessment, Stormwater Utility Model Options, Enterprise Resource Planning system implantation, and Rent Affordability Options.
