Priorities - Policing Transition from RCMP to GPPS

1. Work with Grande Prairie Police Service to integrate service delivery.
Target: Demobilize all remaining (47) RCMP Regular Members (RM).
 - I. 81 have transitioned from Grande Prairie Detachment
 - II. All RM's have received transfer planning documents.
 - III. 23 RM's remaining to demobilize.
2. Bilateral Operations meeting GPPS & RCMP on a weekly basis.
Target: 16 meetings this year.
 - I. YTD: 8 completed
3. Employee Wellness - Ongoing discussions with all employees through daily shift briefings.
Target: Four per week. 75 this year.
 - I. YTD: 32 completed.

Build Trust and Confidence in Policing Service Delivery

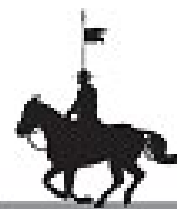
Priorities – Community Engagement and Diversity

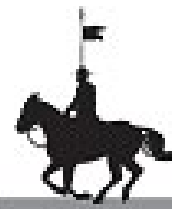
