HELPFUL INFORMATION FOR A GRANDER CANADA DAY

Check out the information below to help make Canada Day celebrations grander for all attendees:

- Bring a mat, blanket or other type of parade seating that is comfortable for sitting and does not disturb other parade viewers.
- Stay on the sidewalk and do not go into the street during the parade.
- Public washrooms are unavailable along the parade route.
- Muskoseepi Park parking is unavailable during the event.
- Ernie Radbourne Pavilion washrooms are available from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m.
- Portable toilets are located around the park until the end of the event.
- Small strollers are recommended as sidewalk space is limited.
- Dress appropriate for weather conditions.
- Liquor is available for purchase at the beer gardens and alcohol is only allowed inside the beer gardens during Canada Day celebrations.
- Attendees cannot bring their own alcohol to the Canada Day event.
- Canada Day celebrations include sudden loud noises and large crowds that may be stressful for your furry friends. We recommend keeping your pets at home if they are sensitive to those things.
- Dispose of garbage and recycling in appropriate receptacles and avoid littering to keep the park and neighbourhood clean.
- Be courteous and respectful while sharing the space with other attendees.
