  - Approved Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) Training Course or Proof of Provincial Equivalencies
  - Valid Advanced First Aid
  - 80-hour MFR program certificate
- Class 3 AND 4 Alberta Driver's License with Air Brakes (Q) Endorsement or Proof of Provincial Equivalencies
- Minimum of a High School Diploma or equivalency
