 [NOTE: ACP registration is NOT required]
 - Approved Emergency Medical Responder *(EMR)* Training Course or Proof of Provincial Equivalencies
 - Valid Advanced First Aid
 - 80-hour MFR program certificate
- Class 3 AND 4 Alberta Driver's License with Air Brakes (Q) Endorsement or Proof of Provincial Equivalencies
- Minimum of a High School Diploma or equivalency
